PATRON OF THE COLLEGE



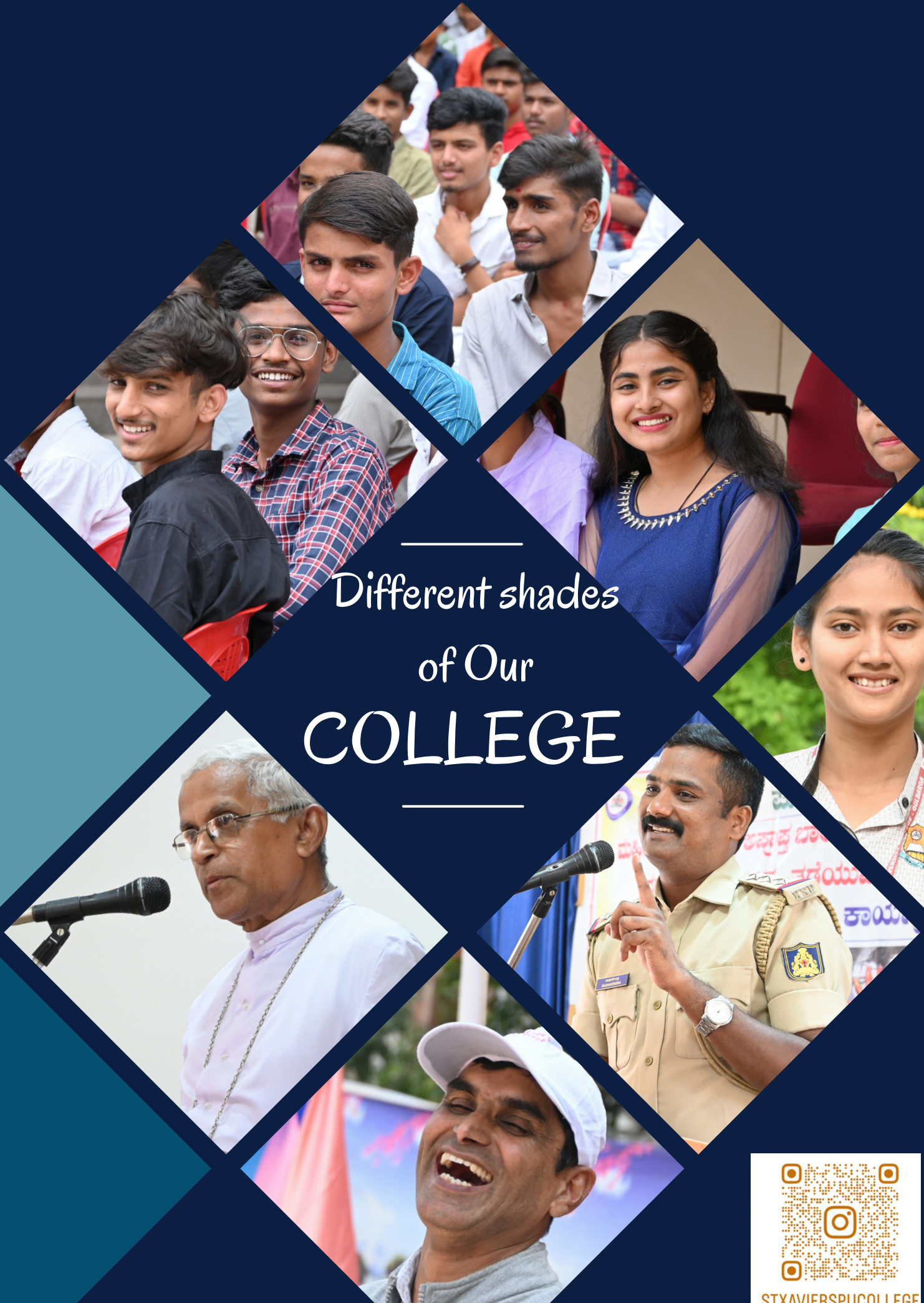
St Francis Xavier was born on 7 April 1506 in Spain. Xavier met Ignatius of Loyola while they both were students at the University of Paris. While Xavier seemed destined for academic success in the line of his noble family, Ignatius repeatedly turned his mind on a life of service by constantly asking him, “Francis, what does it profit a man if he gains the whole world and suffers the loss of his soul?” He became companion and associate of Ignatius in founding the Society of Jesus. Xavier was chosen as the Apostolic Nuncio and ambassador of King John III of Portugal to serve people of Asia. Xavier landed in Goa in 1542. He travelled widely in India and proceeded to Japan preaching the truths of life. He worked among the poor and downtrodden to empower them. While longing to enter China Xavier was taken ill with fever on the island of Sancian and died on 3rd December 1552. The body of Xavier is now placed in the Basilica of Bom Jesu in Goa. It is this example of his life, heroic and noble, not seeking the glory of this world but genuinely concerned about the good of others, that is proposed to the students for emulation here.

THE COLLEGE CREST



The shield-like design is the Crest of the College. It contains the motto, which is the goal of this college. In the right half of the Crest is a leaping lion symbolic of the vigour and boldness one must cultivate. Above the leaping lion is a soaring eagle which implies one not to be satisfied with mediocrity but to aim truly at high intellectual, physical and spiritual development.

On the left side of the Crest is the rising sun with letters IHS. This is the abbreviation of the name of Jesus (the first three letters of Jesus in Greek). That name is symbolic of the deepest faith in God, commitment to people and readiness to sacrifice everything, even one’s life for others. Below the letters is a book which symbolises knowledge and light.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- Application forms for PUC are available in the College Office.
- Admissions are made on the basis of merit and availability of seats. Kindly do not approach with references and recommendations.
- Filled application forms have to be submitted at the admission counter with the 10" standard provisional marks card (internet copy/need not wait for the original marks card) with four recent passport size photographs.
- Kindly choose the subject combinations and the 2 language for the course after enough deliberations and future career requirements. Change of Combination or language may not be possible after admission.
- Candidates who are selected will meet the Principal along with the Parent/Guardian for approval of the admission.
- Provisional admissions will be granted only on payment of requisite fees within the given time approved by the Principal.
- Admissions will be confirmed only after the Original Transfer Certificate from the previous institution as well copies of the original marks card of the qualifying exam are submitted to the office within the date stipulated by the Karnataka Pre-University Board.

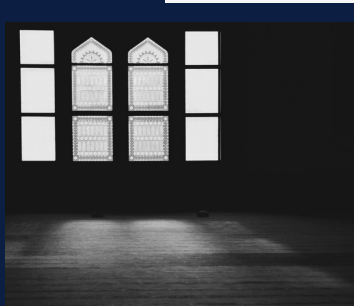
COMPUTER AND LANGUAGE LABS
